Additional Public Holiday in NSW on 7 September 2007

On 28 February 2007, the NSW Government announced that Friday 7 September 2007 would be an additional public holiday in Sydney, to coincide with the Asia-Pacific Economic Co-operation (APEC) Summit.

The Government announced it would declare the public holiday to minimise the disruption that will be caused by the security measures and road closures to be put in place for the APEC Summit. However, the public holiday would be declared in the Sydney Metropolitan area only (including Penrith, Camden and Campbelltown).

This public holiday will impact on all employees and employers who work in the Sydney Metropolitan area.
