### Changes to Qantas Freight Fuel Surcharge

As a result of the recent increase in the price of aviation fuel, the fuel surcharge on all Qantas (QF) and Jetstar (JQ) services ex Australia will be increased with effect from 01 May 2008.

The adjusted fuel surcharge on QF and JQ services will be:

TC3	AUD 0.64 per kg on chargeable weight
TC1 / 2	AUD 0.75per kg on chargeable weight

The adjusted fuel surcharge for all perishable shipments lodged as a built up unit ready for carriage:

•	Loose lodged perishable cargo	AUD 0.75 per kg

Please note:

- The effective date is based on "Executed Date" of AWB
- The fuel surcharge will be non-commissionable
- The fuel surcharge will be applicable to all shipments under General and Express AWB
- The amount will be shown on the AWB under "Other Charges, Due Carrier" box with code **MYC**

We will continue to monitor the price of fuel and advise any further changes accordingly.
