### Changes to Qantas Freight Fuel Surcharge

As a result of recent changes in the aviation fuel price, the fuel surcharge on some Qantas Freight marketed Qantas and Jetstar services ex Australia will be reduced with effect from 16 December 2010.

The adjusted fuel surcharge on QF and JQ services will be:

- TC3 no change at AUD 0.30 per kg
- TC1/2 reduced by \$0.04 to AUD 0.66 per kg

The adjusted fuel surcharge for all shipments lodged and rated as a built up unit ready for carriage will be:

#### TC3

- Type 2/5 AUD 480 per unit
- Type 6 AUD 330 per unit
- Type 8 AUD 210 per unit

#### TC1/2

- Type 2/5 AUD 1055 per unit
- Type 6 AUD 725 per unit
- Type 8 AUD 460 per unit


In conjunction with these changes Qantas Freight sales offices will issue new market rate tariffs to be effective 16 December 2010.

- The effective date is based on "Executed Date" of AWB
- All surcharges are calculated according to the chargeable weight.
- The fuel surcharge will be non-commissionable.
- The fuel surcharge will be applicable to all shipments under General and Express AWB.
- The amount must be shown on the AWB under "Other Charges, Due Carrier" with code **MYC**.

We will continue to monitor the price of fuel and relevant market conditions and adjust the fuel surcharge accordingly.
