Dear Colleagues,

The occurrences during the past months in Egypt, with much distress and sorrow for the local population, have induced the FIATA Presidency to carefully review the situation regarding the carrying out of our World Congress 2011 in Cairo. Many contacts have been established for an evaluation of the situation as safety and security of the Congress participants has always been considered as of utmost importance.

After the political changes in Egypt, FIATA is confident that the problems will be tackled in a democratic and peaceful manner, which will ease the return to a normal situation. The FIATA Presidency has therefore decided to continue with the preparation for the congress 2011 in Cairo, Egypt as originally foreseen. This decision is fully supported by our Association member EIFFA who have worked hard over the last couple of years to make this Congress a big success.

The only change made is the date of the Congress: instead of holding it during the month of September (when the elections for the new parliament will be held) the final date has now been confirmed for

16 to 21st October, 2011.

The printing of the Congress Brochures and Registration Forms will soon be finalized and – once available – immediately be sent out to all our Association and Individual members. Also the special Congress website will soon be ready and available for further information and on-line registration for the Congress.

We are confident that our members will soon start to register for the Congress so that we reach a high number of participants.
