

AICCC Industry Survey on AQIS National Consistency Issues

Dear Industry Stakeholder,

Industry feedback on certain Australian Quarantine and Inspection Services (AQIS) national consistency issues has been conveyed to industry associations, which in turn raised such issues at meetings of the AQIS Industry Cargo Consultative Committee (AICCC). Examples of such issues include differing Quarantine Approved Premises (QAP) registration conditions being applied and varying information requirements for identical shipment between different AQIS regions.

AQIS has requested the AICCC Secretariat to seek wider industry feedback on all such issues and to determine if inconsistencies in relation to AQIS activities are systemic.

The purpose of this survey is to:

- . gather information on AQIS activities where you perceive inconsistencies may occur,
- . obtain examples of such inconsistencies
- . determine whether such inconsistencies are systemic and
- . work with AQIS to eliminate such issues
