**PROCESSED DRIED CURRANTS
EXPORTED FROM GREECE**

Measures

Interim dumping measures have been imposed on processed dried currants (currants) exported from Greece. All exporters are subject to interim dumping duty.

Description of the goods

The goods subject to anti-dumping measures are currants of the grape variety *Vitis Vinifera L. Black Corinth*.

The measures do not apply to:

- buck currants;
- red currants;
- berries (e.g. red berries;
- sultanas;
- Muscat raisins;
- unprocessed currants; or
- blended dried fruit mixtures.

Goods subject to measures should be classified using the tariff sub-heading and associated statistical code contained in Table 1.

Dates of Effect

Interim dumping duties were initially imposed on 15 January 2009.

Direction for collection of interim dumping duties

Goods subject to the measures must be entered using the dumping specification number (DSN) as shown in Table 2.

The interim dumping duty (IDD) payable and the ascertained export price (AEP) are shown in Table 3.

The total amount of interim dumping duty (IDD) payable shall be the sum of:

- the amount equal to the IDD as shown in Table 3; plus
- the amount, if any, by which the dumping export price (DXP) is less than the AEP.

Release of details of measures

The interim duty rates and the ascertained export price (AEP) in Table 3 are considered Confidential and will not be published.

Bona Fide importers of the goods may be provided with the confidential information. Unless an importer is able to demonstrate a trading history for currants with an exporter/supplier in Greece, no confidential information will be provided.

Where no prior pattern of imports exists, evidence of an offer, quotation or acceptance of an order from an exporter/supplier is considered the minimum requirement before confidential information may be disclosed.

Customs will conduct monitoring of imports consistent with its published policy.

PINEAPPLE FRUIT - PREPARED OR PRESERVED IN CONTAINERS EXPORTED FROM THAILAND, THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES

Measures

⇒Anti-dumping measures have been imposed on:

- pineapple fruit prepared or preserved in containers not exceeding 1 litre (consumer pineapple) exported from Thailand and The Republic of the Philippines (the Philippines); and
- pineapple fruit prepared or preserved in containers exceeding 1 litre (food service and industrial (FSI pineapple)) exported from Thailand, the Peoples Republic of China (China) and the Philippines.

Description of the goods

The consumer pineapple covered by the measures is supplied in cans or other containers (e.g. plastic cups) not exceeding 1 litre.

The FSI pineapple covered by the measures is supplied in cans or other containers (e.g. 10 kg aseptic bags) exceeding 1 litre.

Pineapple subject to measures should be classified using the tariff sub-headings and associated statistical codes contained in Table 1.

Exempt exporters

⇒There is one exporter of consumer pineapple exempt from the measures: Thai Pineapple Canning Industry Corp Ltd (TPC) from Thailand. Exemption type 'SUPPLIER' applies to consumer pineapple manufactured and exported by TPC.

⇒There is one exporter of FSI pineapple exempt from the measures: Malee Sampran Public Co. Limited (Malee Sampran) from Thailand. Exemption type 'SUPPLIER' applies to FSI pineapple manufactured and exported by Malee Sampran.

All other exporters and suppliers are subject to the measures as advised in Table 2 below.

Dates of Effect

Anti-dumping measures on consumer and FSI pineapple exported from Thailand were initially imposed on 18 October 2001. The measures on consumer pineapple exported from Thailand were last revised on 10 October 2006. The measures on FSI pineapple were last revised on 19 April 2008.

Anti-dumping measures on consumer pineapple exported from the Philippines were initially imposed on 11 October 2006. Anti-dumping measures on FSI pineapple exported from the Philippines were initially imposed on 14 November 2006. The measures on consumer and FSI pineapple were last revised on 30 August 2011.

Anti-dumping duties on FSI pineapple exported from China were initially imposed on 11 October 2006.

Identifying the goods subject to measures

Canned FSI pineapple should not be incorrectly classified to 2008.92.00/40.

⇒Glace and dehydrated pineapple are not covered by the measures.

⇒A reference to 'net weight' means a reference to the total weight of the total contents of the can/container.

PINEAPPLE FRUIT - PREPARED OR PRESERVED IN CONTAINERS EXPORTED FROM THAILAND, THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES

For FSI pineapple entered under statistical code 27, the applicable unit of quantity for Customs duty is litres. However for dumping duty purposes the applicable unit of quantity is kilograms. **Kilograms should be converted to litres by dividing the number of kilograms by 1.043174.**

Direction for collection of interim dumping duty

Goods subject to the measures must be entered using the relevant dumping specification number (DSN) for the nominated exporter/supplier from each country as shown in Table 2. The interim duty rates and the ascertained export price (AEP) for each DSN are shown in Table 3.

The total amount of interim dumping duty payable shall be the sum of:

- the amount equal to the interim dumping duty per kilogram shown in Table 3; plus
- the amount, if any, by which the dumping export price (DXP) is less than the AEP shown in Table 3.

Release of details of measures

The interim duty rates and the ascertained export price (AEP) for each DSN in Table 3 are considered Confidential and will not be published.

Bona Fide importers of the goods may be provided with the confidential information relevant to a nominated exporter/supplier or country (in the case of China). Unless an importer is able to demonstrate a trading history with the nominated exporter/supplier or country, no confidential information for that exporter/supplier or country will be provided.

Where no prior pattern of imports exists, evidence of an offer, quotation or acceptance of an order from a nominated exporter/supplier is considered the minimum requirement before confidential information relevant to that exporter/supplier or country may be disclosed.

Customs will conduct monitoring of imports consistent with its published policy.
