## ComTrac Release

Container tracking via 1-Stop is now available in Cyberfreight. Cyberfreight jobs are automatically updated with the container movement dates from the 1-Stop data feed. Movement data includes in/out of ports and most MT yards. Please contact us or 1-Stop for details.

## CargoSmart Interface Released

Following on from the recent release of the INTTRA interface, Cyberfreight now has an interface to CargoSmart. CargoSmart and INTTRA enable electronic bookings and other communications with shipping lines. This facility allows you to make bookings 24x7 as you do not need to deal with a booking clerk by phone.

## Post Codes for FWB & FHL – Shipments destined for Europe

One of the elements of the EU Customs reporting changes that came into effect on 01JAN11 was the requirement for the inclusion of Postal Codes in the Consignee segments of the FWB & FHL. A number of airlines have raised concerns that not all FWB & FHL's are being provided with post codes. There have also been reports that some EU destination consolidations are missing FHL's all together. The failure to provide the Postal Code information in the Consignee segment of the FWB & FHL can result in import processing delays at destination, or in some cases, even off-loads en-route. To ensure your shipments are not impacted, please pay particular attention to ensuring the following:

- 1/ FHL's are always sent for shipments destined EU
- 2/ Goods descriptions are always accurate
- 3/ Postal Codes are always included in the Consignee segments
