Transport & Warehouse Web Portals

The Transport module has a web portal that enables clients to book and monitor cartage jobs. Bookings can be accepted or rejected by the cartage controller.

The Warehouse web portal allows clients to input deliveries into the warehouse and sales orders for picking and dispatch. Clients can also check stock levels.

Backup your digital certificates

A reminder to backup the certificates and create a file (Word or TXT) that contains the digital certificate password and the email address password for each digital certificate. Put a copy of above on a CD or USB memory stick and have one copy on site and one copy off site. If you have a computer failure and you do not have backups as above then you may have to apply for new digital certificates. It may take a couple of weeks to get new digital certificates and in the meantime you will not be able to communicate with Customs. Make new backups when you renew your digital certificates!

Check for late Sea Cargo Reports

The date of the vessel arrival as supplied by Customs is checked against each job and if a Cargo Report has not been sent in the required time frame then the job can be reported. To access this facility go to Freight--> Customs Cargo Status then select "Sea Cargo report not sent" Tab. The Comserver can be configured to automatically send a "Sea Cargo not sent" report at 10PM everyday.

Terms & Conditions

Cyberfreight can be configured to print terms and conditions on the back of most

documents. You will need a duplex printer (prints both sides) in order for this facility to work. The terms & conditions are RTF word processing files and you can maintain them as required. Using plain paper and a laser printer provides more flexibility than using pre-printed forms. If you have a pre-printed forms and you need to change the terms & conditions or other details on the face of the document then you will have to throw out remaining stocks.

Reports – business intelligence

Cyberfreight has many reports that cover operations and accounts. These reports can provide valuable business intelligence about your business and your clients. It is important to at least look at reports about how long clients are taking to pay their invoices. Delayed payment effectively costs you money as there is an interest cost of not having the money in your bank account. Secondly, with all of the uncertainty of the current global financial system you need to keep an eye on slow payers as this could be an indication of a risk of the client going "bad".

Try the various reports and see how they can assist you.

Container Tracking, Cargo Availability & Sailing Schedule

Cyberfreight can receive electronic feeds from 1-Stop and Tradegate that contain sailing schedules, availability of cargo at the wharf and containers movements. Cyberfreight jobs are automatically updated with the dates from the 1-Stop or Tradegate data feeds. Container movement data includes in/out of ports and most MT yards.
