Qantas Freight Terminal Service Fees

Qantas Freight will introduce a new schedule of service fees at its Australian based terminals from 01 September 2012.

These fees have not changed since May 2011 and once again we have managed to maintain many of our service fees and minimum charges below current market rates.

The enclosed document outlines the new schedule of fees which includes the following:

- A new service charge for the processing of electronic reporting of an eFreight shipment with amendments required
- The continuation of a discounted Export Document Fee for genuine eFreight shipments with no accompanying documents intended for travel
- The introduction of a significant discount in Export Security Fees for shipments presented by an approved RACA and supported by a Chain of Custody Statement.

All fees are advertised inclusive of all applicable taxes.

Please assist us in ensuring that all relevant team members in your business are aware of the updated schedule.

For general freight lodged 36 hours or less prior to the scheduled time of departure	No Charge

6. Export Build Up Fee

Export freight must be tendered in accordance with the accompanying documentation or pre-received electronic data

8. Dangerous Goods Acceptance Fee

For shipments of Dangerous Goods tendered for carriage on

Passenger aircraft (up to three pieces)

13. International Terminal Fee (all fees include GST)

For all shipments arriving through the Qantas Australian Freight Terminals the following fees apply;

a. For loose freight (minimum fee) *\$0.418 per kg

b. For shipments arriving as 'shipper loaded' on the air waybill and delivered intact (ULDs rated or number of pieces refers to the number of ULDs)

For shipments arriving as multi-pieces loaded at origin as ULDs by shipper or their agent, manifested as one line only and delivered intact

Explanatory notes:

1. Effective 01 September 2012, subject to variation with a minimum 15 days notice
2. The air waybill refers to both a paper version (AWB) or an electronic version (FWB) and a paperless version is referred to as eFreight (eAWB)
3. The house air waybill refers to both a paper version (HAWB) or an electronic version (FHL)
4. GST application is based on Australian Government determinations. GST is **included** where fees are marked with an asterisk (*)
5. Storage fees when applied are in addition to other fee applications
