Fuel Surcharge Amendment - Australia

As a result of recent changes in the aviation fuel price, the fuel surcharge for Qantas and Jetstar services marketed by Qantas Freight ex Australia will be adjusted from 31 March 2013.

The adjusted fuel surcharge on QF and JQ services will be:

TC3	AUD0.36 per kg
TC1/2	AUD0.84 per kg

The fuel surcharge for all shipments lodged as a built up unit ready for carriage will be:

• Type 5 and 2	AUD545.00 per unit
• Type 6	AUD375.00 per unit
• Type 8	AUD240.00 per unit
TC 1/2	
• Type 5 and 2	AUD1,270.00 per unit
• Type 6/6a/6w	AUD880.00 per unit
• Type 8	AUD560.00 per unit

In conjunction with these changes, Australian sales offices will issue adjusted market rate tariffs effective 31 March 2013.

- The effective date is based on "Executed Date" of the AWB.
- The fuel surcharge will be calculated according to the chargeable weight.
- The fuel surcharge will be non-commissionable.
- The fuel surcharge will be applicable to all shipments under General and Express AWB.
- The amount must be shown on the AWB under "Other Charges, Due Carrier" with MYC.

We will continue to monitor fuel prices and adjust the surcharge accordingly. If you have any enquiries, please contact your local Freight sales office.
