Update to [Industry Notice 59](#) and [Industry Notice 64](#)

Outage to go ahead as planned on Sunday 25 August 2013

DAFF would like to advise clients that the changes detailed in [Notice to Industry 59](#) and [64](#) have been confirmed as going ahead and will commence on Sunday 25 August 2013 at 8 pm with the maintenance window expected to close at 3 am on Monday 26 August 2013.

Who does this affect?

International vessel masters, shipping agents, Importers and Brokers who rely on the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF) for entry processing of Full Import Declarations (FIDs), Long Form Self Assessed Clearances (LFSAC), Short Form Self assessed Clearances (SFSAC), Cargo Reports (CRSAC and Cargo Reports) and any automated entry processing such as Automated Entry Processing and Imported Food processing.

Information

There will be planned work undertaken on DAFF Information and Communications Technology (ICT) Infrastructure commencing at 8 pm on Sunday 25 August, with the maintenance window expected to close at 3 am on Monday 26 August 2013.

During the above indicated timeframe, DAFF's automated import systems and officers will have intermittent access to external communications, which will affect and include email, automated messaging with Customs.

This will cause pre-arrival reporting and entry processing delays through the above timeframe
