

Tradegate reduces MaxeTrade network prices

Tradegate has reduced the cost of MaxeTrade secure network connections for the benefit of Tradegate members and the wider business community.

SYDNEY 27th September 2006 – Tradegate ECA, the e-commerce facilitator for the Australian trade and transport community, has announced price cuts for the MaxeTrade private communications network which provides the organisation’s members with secure, direct connectivity with Australian Customs.

Due to take effect on October 1, the price cuts will apply to the fixed price network connections of all existing clients. Cost recovery pricing is currently under review and revised levels will be announced soon.

The cost of the EDI Message Direct service remains unchanged although Tradegate is trying to negotiate a lower price with service provider AAPT.

“The MaxeTrade price reductions will take effect automatically,” says Tradegate general manager Brian Farquhar. “There is no need for clients to do anything to gain these benefits.”
